1. You must submit a non-refundable \$30 application fee. This fee may be waived if you have contributed \$30 to PACC in the past year. When requesting a waiver, please let us know when you made your contribution.
2. You must be currently enrolled in the workshop for which you are applying.
3. The scholarship fund will pay the monies directly to Pathways Institute.
4. Recipients must complete the workshop for which the grant was received; if they choose not to complete it, monies must be returned to the PACC scholarship fund.
5. The maximum amount awarded to an individual by the PACC scholarship program is a total of \$2,500.
